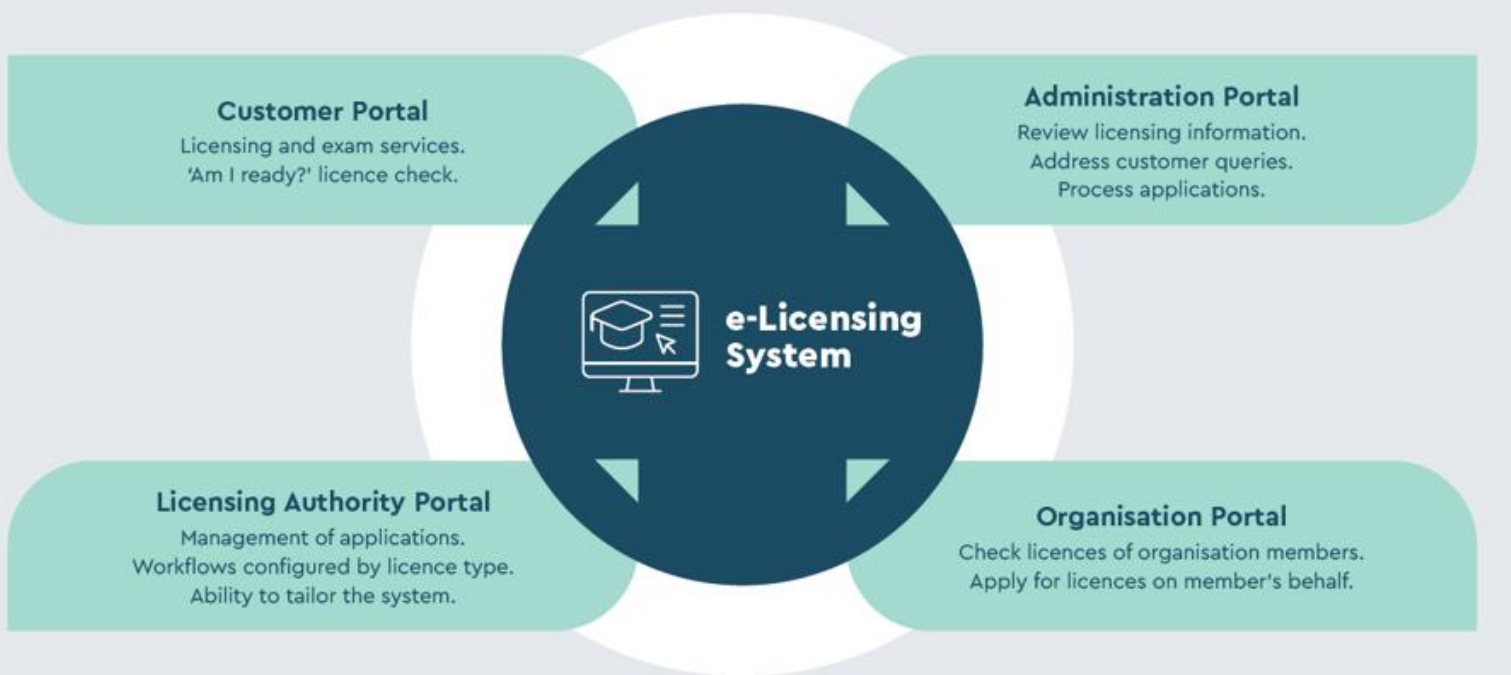

Apply for license and ratings

Apply for license and ratings on applicant's behalf

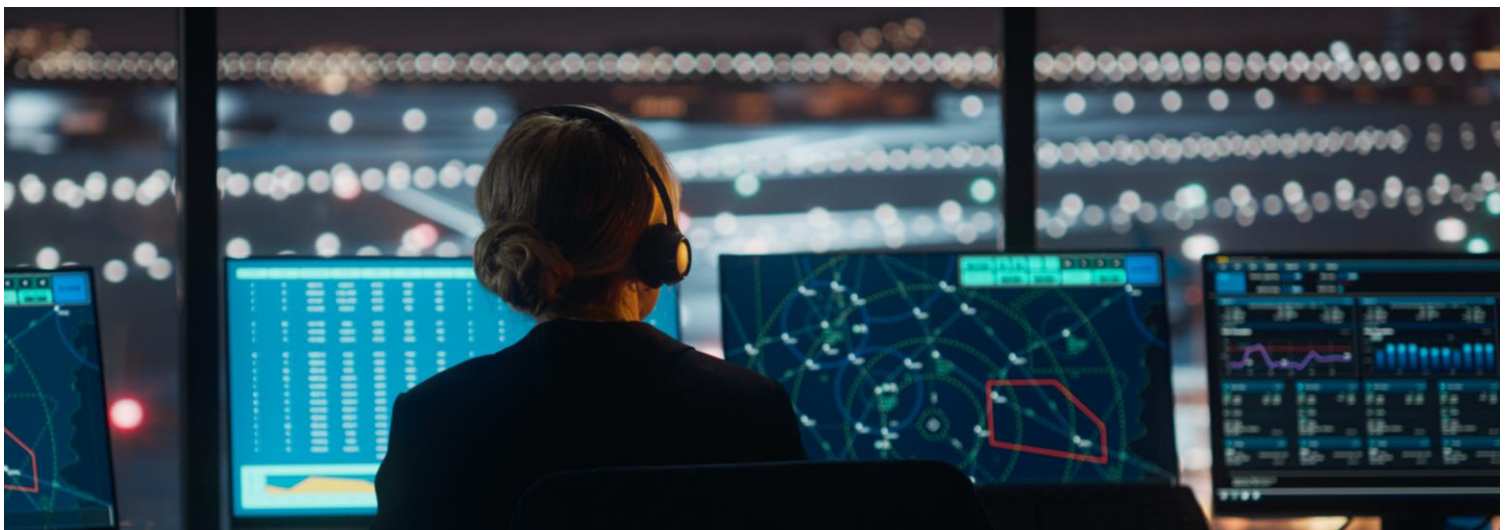
Online payment and application process for new licenses and ratings, and to renew or revalidate existing licenses on the applicant's behalf.

Licensing Authority Portal

Approve license applications

Delegate work assignments

Assign license applications to licensing administrative staff with clear application processing time allocations.

Print Licenses

After the license application has been approved, licenses can be reviewed and printed to be sent to applicants.
